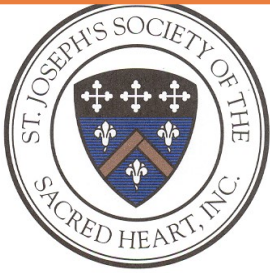

Did You Know?

"Battered Child Syndrome" is a clinical term professionals use to refer to children experiencing recurrent physical abuse from a caretaker over an extended period of time. Signs of a battered child can include repeated bruising or bruising in unusual places, broken bones, scratches, and

other injuries. Even if you do not see physical abuse happening, such injuries may be signs that a child is in danger in his or her own home. You should report any suspicious injuries or symptoms to a local child protective services agency — that report could save a child's life.

Sabia Usted? El "Síndrome del niño maltratado" es un término clínico que los profesionales usan para referirse a niños que experimentan abuso físico recurrente por parte de un cuidador, durante un período prolongado de tiempo. Los signos de un niño maltratado pueden incluir moretones esporádicos o moretones repetidos en lugares inusuales, huesos rotos, rasguños y otras lesiones. Aunque usted no vea el abuso físico, tales lesiones pueden ser signos de que un/a niño/a está en peligro en su propia casa. Usted debe reportar cualquier lesión o síntoma sospechoso a una agencia local de servicios de protección infantil, ya que ese informe podría salvar la vida de un/a niño/a

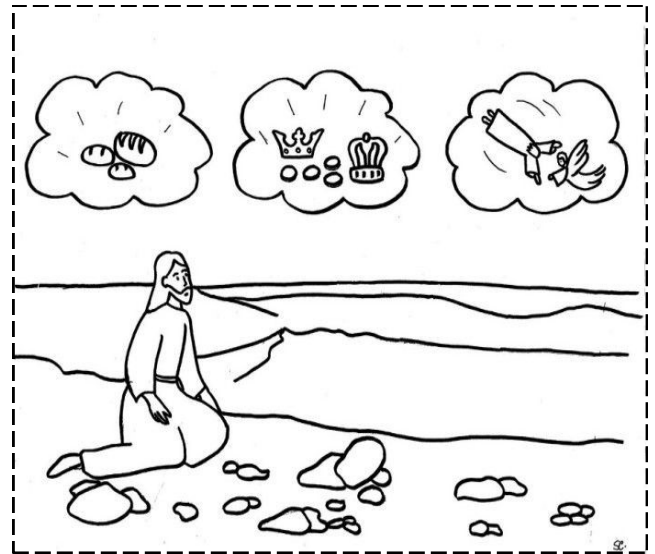
