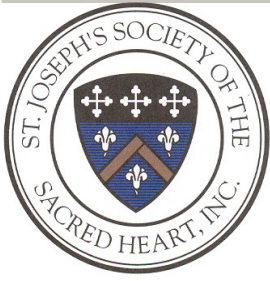

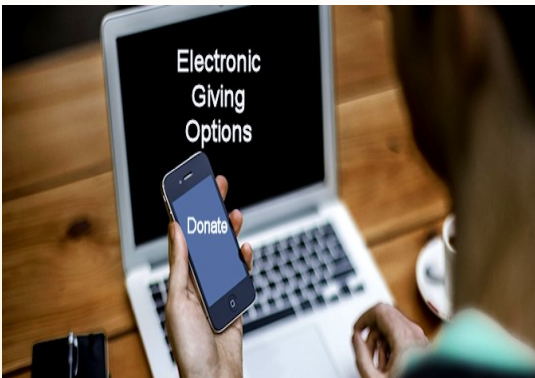

2. PRAY

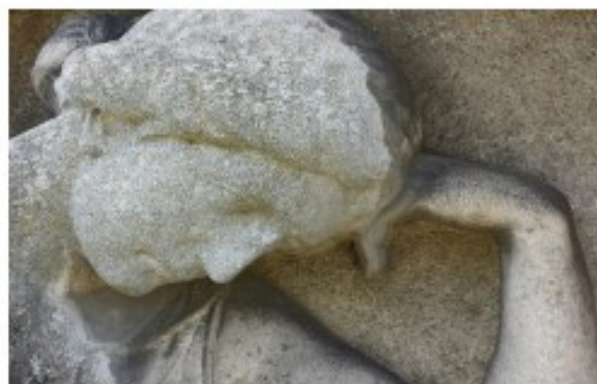
